

National Partnership on Literacy and Numeracy

Our school has been given the opportunity to participate in the National Partnership on Literacy and Numeracy. This is a state-wide program involving government and non-government schools and represents significant funding from the Commonwealth Government to New South Wales schools, as well as a co-contribution from the State Government.

Common to all schools in this National Partnership is the objective of raising overall attainment so that NSW primary school students in Stages 2 and 3 gain reading or numeracy skills to actively engage in school and in society.

Our school executive has participated in a recently developed school leadership program and will work with teachers to support whole school strategies aimed at improving our student outcomes in reading. Teachers will have ongoing professional development to support a new literacy program, Focus on Reading, a whole class program, and for students experiencing difficulty in reading we are developing individual learning plans and will access a specific literacy intervention program called Multilit.
